# Artwork by Vik Muniz

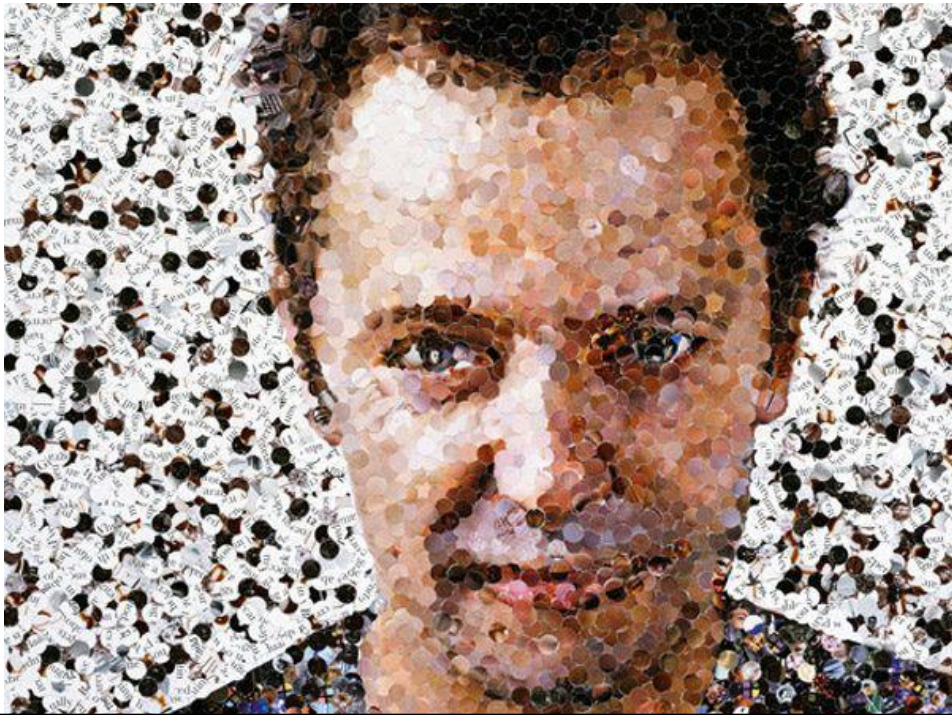
